Rules for admission of foreign students to study at JSC "YUKMA"

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Admission of foreign citizens to study at JSC "YUKMA" on a paid basis is carried out according to the results of an interview / testing conducted by the admission committee of the university during the calendar year. At the same time, enrollment of foreign citizens is carried out in accordance with the academic calendar 5 (five) days before the beginning of the next academic period.

In order to conduct an interview / testing with foreign citizens for enrollment on a paid basis, an examination commission is created.

The order on the formation of the examination commission is issued annually for the period of work of the admissions committee.

The examination commission is formed on the basis of the order of the rector of JSC "YUKMA".

The examination commission includes the top management of the Academy (rector, vice-rector), deans, representatives of the teaching staff of departments on the recommendation of the deans of faculties.

The number of members of the commission must be an odd number. Meetings of the commission are considered competent if there are at least two-thirds of its members.

The chairman of the examination commission is the rector of the Academy, his deputy is the first vice–rector. By order of the rector, the secretary of the examination commission is appointed.

DESCRIPTION OF THE PROCESS

Applications are accepted by the admission committee of JSC "YUKMA" through the automated information system "Platonus". A foreign citizen must provide the following documents:

- application for enrollment;
- contract for the provision of educational services 3 copies .;
- a notarized copy of the identity document (passport) with an officially certified translation into Kazakh and/or Russian 2 copies.;
- a state—issued document on general secondary, primary vocational, secondary vocational or higher vocational education (original) or a document of a foreign state on education recognized as equivalent in the Republic of Kazakhstan to a state-issued document on general secondary, primary vocational, secondary vocational or higher vocational education with an officially certified translation into Kazakh and/or Russian 2 copies;
- 6 3x4 photo cards;
- medical certificate form 075/Y with a fluorogram image (after arrival at JSC "YUKMA");
- vaccination passport;
- medical report confirming the absence of HIV infection (after arrival at JSC "YUKMA");
- NEET results (for Indian citizens).

Documents submitted in a foreign language must have a notarized translation into the state or Russian language. The certification of the translation into Kazakh or Russian is carried out by a notary in the territory of the Republic of Kazakhstan or by the bodies of the diplomatic service of the Republic of Kazakhstan in the country in which the document was issued.

Documents on education issued by foreign educational organizations undergo the nostrification procedure in accordance with the procedure established by the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan after enrollment of persons during the 1st (first) academic period of study.

Admission of foreign citizens to study at JSC "YUKMA" on a fee basis is carried out by the admission committee of the university based on the results of testing in general education disciplines: language of instruction, mathematics, biology, chemistry and psychometric testing.

The number of test tasks for each subject is 20. The correct answer to each test task is evaluated by one point.

Foreign citizens who have scored at least 70 points in the educational programs "General Medicine"; "Dentistry", "Pediatrics", "Pharmacy", "Public Health", "Nursing"; at least 50 points in the specialty "Pharmaceutical production Technology" are enrolled in JSC "YUKMA" for paid training." from the total number of 100 tests, including at least 5 points in the language of instruction, chemistry, biology, mathematics and psychometric testing.

According to the results of testing, a statement of results is drawn up.
